A volume on the Imperial Bonsai was presented by the Japanese Embassy to the Ikebana International Chapter No. 1, Inc. in May, 1980, in appreciation of the work of the chapter in promoting the art of Ikebana in this area. The beautiful 12" x 15" book, bound in silk brocade is a very limited edition published by Japan Hoso (Broadcasting) Association in 1976. Although it is not yet considered a "rare book" according to Mr. Isao Matsumoto, head of the Japanese section of the Library of Congress, it could very well become so classed in the future. It is currently evaluated at about \$200. Of the known other volumes in this area, two were purchased by the Library of Congress, one each was given to the Arboretum and the Bonsai Society, and the Japanese Embassy has at least one copy. The volume contains not only beautiful color photographs of all of the famous Imperial Bonsai but also a most interesting preface and short history of Bonsai written by the Grand Chamberlain of the Imperial household. The book is in the custody of our librarian.
